Apply Acelepryn as a soil drench or soil injection application within 6 inches of the trunks of pine trees. Trees may be treated at a high rate (0.15 fl oz Acelepryn per tree) or a low rate (0.075 fl oz Acelepryn per tree). Acelepryn should be diluted to a 50:50 product:water suspension. When applied to seedlings or trees at planting, both rates can provide one year of Nantucket Pine Tip Moth suppression to small trees, and high rates can protect trees for two years.
